VA HEALTHCARE ID CARDS

August – 12, 8 am - 3 pm
Bishop City Hall

The Sierra Nevada VA Health Care System will be bringing equipment to take photos for Veteran Health Identification Card (VHIC) on August 12th at the Bishop City Hall from 8 am - 3 pm. If you do not have a VHIC or the card you have in your possession is outdated (ie: current VHIC attached), you can achieve this at this event.

You must bring the following documents:

- Primary form of government-issued photo identification and one secondary form of identification (ie: Driver License, DMV ID card, Passport, Military ID card) or
- Two primary forms of identification (ie: Social Security Card, Certified Birth Certificate, Native American Tribal Document)

If your primary or secondary forms of ID do not contain your address, the following documents have been designated as being acceptable proof:

- Phone bill from a local phone service provider
- Electric bill from a local electrical service provider
- Credit card statement
- Checking or Savings Account statement
- Property tax bill
- VBA documents with correct address

This is also an opportunity for those that need to update their address to be able to access Choice Program to do so at this event.
