COLLEGE TUITION WAIVED!

Children of veterans with a "service-connected" disability from the Department of Veterans Affairs ("The VA") may qualify for waiver of tuition and other State-wide fees at any State Community College, State College and even State Universities.

There are several ways to qualify for this program. Eligibility may be based on the age or the income of the student.
